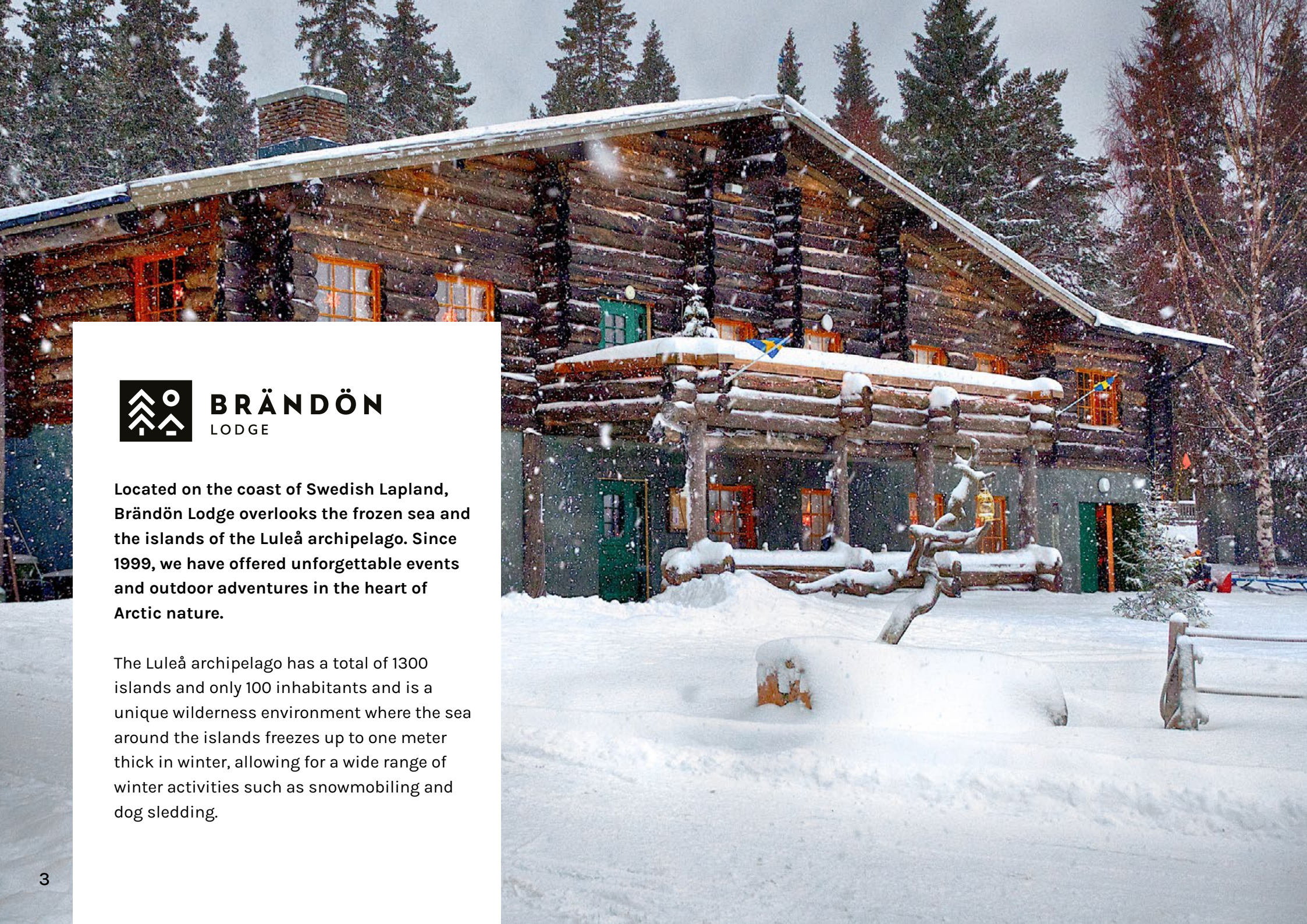

BRÄNDÖN LODGE

Located on the coast of Swedish Lapland, Brändön Lodge overlooks the frozen sea and the islands of the Luleå archipelago. Since 1999, we have offered unforgettable events and outdoor adventures in the heart of Arctic nature.

The Luleå archipelago has a total of 1300 islands and only 100 inhabitants and is a unique wilderness environment where the sea around the islands freezes up to one meter thick in winter, allowing for a wide range of winter activities such as snowmobiling and dog sledding.

Brändön Lodge feels like one big family – we welcome everybody with a big smile and open arms. The CEO, Göran, truly values personal connections with guests, and that spirit is reflected throughout the team. As a result, many of our guests return year after year.

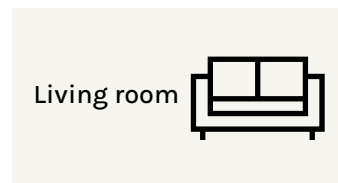
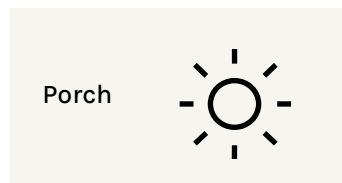
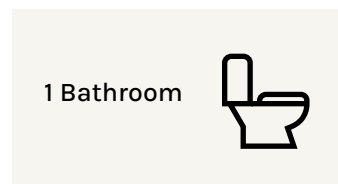
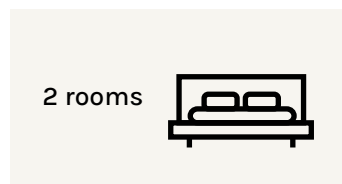
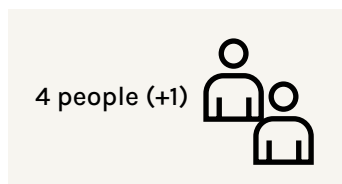
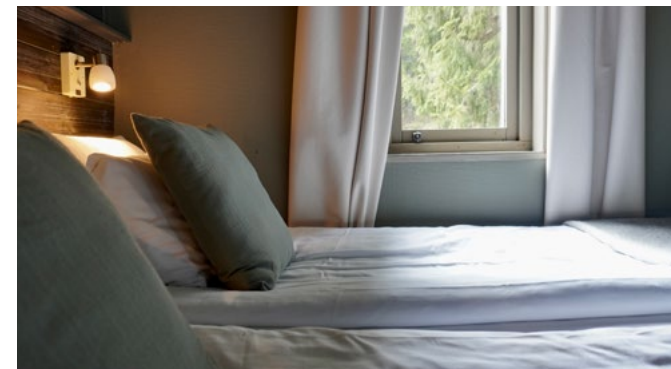


Accommodation

Brändön Lodge Cabins

We have 15 fantastic hotel cabins at Brändön Lodge! Each cabin has two bedrooms, a bathroom, a living room and a veranda with a view of the archipelago.

The bedrooms have two single beds. On request, the single beds in one room can be made up into a queen size bed. It is also possible to add an extra bed in the living room for an additional cost. All cabins also have a sofa, a toilet and shower in the bathroom and a fridge.





Restaurant

Located on the top floor of our timber log cabin, the restaurant offers a cozy and welcoming atmosphere. Our chefs from around the world serve a daily breakfast buffet, soup of the day, and a delicious 3-course dinner.

We started serving our classic Swedish Christmas buffet shortly after Brändön Lodge was founded in 1999. In Sweden, the Christmas buffet is a cherished holiday tradition, and ours has become one of the things Brändön Lodge is best known for. Everything is homemade from scratch, and we even have a whole room dedicated to desserts.





Adventures

Snowmobile



Forest and ice tour snowmobile tour

Your adventure begins with a personal briefing by our local nature guides. After safety instructions, you will get acquainted with your modern snowmobile – the natural way for locals to get through the vast forests and across the frozen lakes. You will follow well-established trails, ensuring a smooth ride and minimal environmental impact.

As you travel through the peaceful landscape, your guides will share fascinating insights into the region's nature, people and history. You will make regular stops to soak up the Arctic tranquility and visit some of our guides' most beloved and beautiful locations.

Duration: 4h with lunch cooked outside or 2h with Swedish fika.



Northern Lights snowmobile tour

Prepare for the ultimate Arctic thrill! Our Northern Lights Snowmobile Tour is not just a tour; it's your high-octane hunt to witness the most spectacular light show on Earth. This is the perfect combination of pure adventure and breathtaking nature. Feel the adrenaline rush as you hurtle through the dark, silent landscape on a powerful snowmobile, where the only light comes from the moon, the stars and the pristine white snow. This is not a passive experience – you are an active part of the journey, carving your own path through the Arctic night.

Duration: 2,5h with Swedish fika.



Nordic Winter Skills incl. lunch

Want a real Arctic adventure? Our Nordic Winter Skills tour is a hands-on, three-hour experience in the snowy wilderness of Swedish Lapland. Snowshoe through the forests around Brändön Lodge with expert guides and learn essential Arctic survival skills—like building a fire in the snow and brewing tea or coffee over open flames. Duration: 3h with lunch cooked outside.



Ice Fishing

This is more than just fishing! It's a chance to get up close to the Arctic marine environment and learn about our unique way of life. Your guide will tell you about the frozen sea, how to read ice conditions, and how to move safely in this icy world. Once we have drilled our holes, the fun begins! A common catch here is perch or, if you are lucky, pike. Anything you catch can be taken back to the lodge for lunch. Duration: 2h with Swedish fika.



Cross Country Skiing

Discover the magic of cross-country skiing. On this guided tour, perfect for beginners, families, and anyone wanting to experience a classic Swedish winter activity. After getting fitted with equipment and learning the basics from your guide, you'll head out on a tour adapted to the snow conditions and your skill level. During the tour, we'll stop for a warm drink and enjoy the silence of the winter wilderness. Minimum 2 people per booking.



Sami Reindeer Experience incl. lunch

Meet local Sami guide Jon-Anders at Brändön Lodge and gain a unique insight into Sami culture and life with reindeer. Visit the reindeer enclosure, learn about the eight Sami seasons and how nature guides daily life, then enjoy a walk with the reindeer through the peaceful surroundings.

The experience continues in a traditional Sami tent, where you'll gather around the fire for tea, conversation, and a lunch cooked over the open fire. Minimum 2 people per booking.



IceBreaker Kalix including transfer

Experience the power of the Arctic on an unforgettable icebreaker adventure in the Baltic Sea. After a transfer from Brändön Lodge or Pine Bay Lodge to the port in Kalix, you'll board a massive icebreaker and watch it carve through thick sea ice.

The highlight of the tour is the chance to float in the icy water wearing a survival suit – a rare and exciting experience in the wake of the ship.

Enjoy complimentary tea and coffee on board while taking in the stunning winter scenery. The tour lasts around two hours and includes transfers to and from the icebreaker. Pick-up: 8:15 AM Return: Around 1:15 PM. Minimum 2 people per booking.



Gammelstad Church Village Tour

UNESCO World Heritage Site with roots dating back to the 14th century. Join us for a 3-hour tour of Gammelstad Church Town. After a short transfer, your guide will take you through the historic village and share stories about its history, culture, and importance to northern Sweden. You'll also enjoy a traditional Swedish coffee break along the way. Perfect for anyone looking to combine a relaxing excursion with a glimpse into Swedish history. Minimum 2 people per booking.



Fatbike tour

Leave the asphalt behind and discover the Luleå archipelago in the most playful way possible. The extra-wide tires provide incredible grip on the snow, snowmobile tracks, and on the frozen sea—pure freedom on two wheels. Includes Swedish "fika" break with coffee and a snack.

Duration: Approx. 3 hours

Group Size: To ensure a personal and safe experience, we host groups of 2-4 people per tour.



Meet Santa Claus

Let the Brändö Santa distribute the Christmas presents this year. Imagine walking through a sparkling, snow-covered forest. The only sounds are the crunch of snow under your snowshoes. Suddenly, in the middle of the quiet forest, a warm glow appears. There, in his cabin, Santa himself is waiting for you. He welcomes you with a smile. The children not only get to meet Santa, but also receive a gift from him.

Dinner on Ice™

An experience for all the senses. Snow white landscape in the midwinter darkness. Candelabra, linen tablecloths, a crackling fire and a three-course gourmet meal. All on ice. Literally. Because we are out on the Gulf of Bothnia. Knowing the sea is below us gives the dinner a new dimension. Walk along a 300-metre path of flares beneath the starry sky, with a chance to see the Northern Lights, before arriving at a lávvu tent where you're welcomed with a warm drink and an introduction to the evening.

Inside the freezing tent, you sit on reindeer-skin benches at beautifully set tables, lit by fire and paraffin lamps. Drinks are chilled in the ice floor while you enjoy northern flavours like salmon, reindeer meat and bilberries—an unforgettable dinner experience. We welcome groups of 20-350 people.

Dinner on ice is a unique trademarked activity, you can not do it anywhere else in the world.



Aurora Hideaway Dinner

Enjoy a magical candlelit dinner on the frozen Gulf of Bothnia, beginning with a snowmobile sleigh ride from your lodge. At the Aurora Hideaway, you're welcomed into a warm, cozy setting with a fireplace and candlelight, along with a drink of your choice. You will be served a 3-course dinner. Between courses you can step outside to look for the Northern Lights or admire the starry silence. Your guide prepares the main course over an open fire, giving it a delicious smoky flavor. Our Aurora Hideaways are mobile "restaurants" that we move around with a tracked trailer. We welcome groups of 2-10 people. Duration: 2,5h



Northern Lights Nature Tour by Snowmobile Sled

Sit back and relax in the sled pulled by a snowmobile. A two-hour search for the northern lights where your nature guide will teach you about the fantastic natural phenomenon and the science behind it. In this activity you sit in a snowmobile drawn sled filled with reindeer pelts and blankets. Our guides drive the snowmobiles that are pulling the sleds as we search for the Northern Lights. We head out across the frozen sea. On the way we will stop regularly and the guides will inform you about the local nature (including sea, forest and wildlife) as well as their arctic lifestyle. We will also stop to make a fire in the snow to boil tea, coffee or chocolate and wait for the Aurora to appear in the sky. Min. 2 pax per booking. Duration: 2h



Northern Lights Snowshoe walk with dinner

We take a guided snowshoe walk through the forest, where you'll learn about the environment and, if conditions allow, spot the northern lights. Your guide will explain the science behind the aurora, while you also learn to light a fire in the snow, identify stars, and spot wildlife tracks. We'll pause to enjoy coffee, tea, and Swedish fika by the fire. On the 3-hour tour, dinner is prepared outdoors and enjoyed on reindeer furs under the night sky.



Northern Lights snowmobile tour

Don't just chase the Northern Lights – chase them in style. Prepare for the ultimate Arctic thrill! Our Northern Lights Snowmobile Tour is not just a tour; it's your high-octane hunt to witness the most spectacular light show on Earth. This is the perfect combination of pure adventure and breathtaking nature. Feel the adrenaline rush as you hurtle through the dark, silent landscape on a powerful snowmobile.



Restaurant Dinner at Brändön Lodge and Northern Lights Guide

A fabulous 2 course dinner in the cozy log timber restaurant which is renowned for its cuisine and service. Leaving the city lights behind our transfer will take you to Brändön Lodge, just north of Luleå. This is a fantastic northern lights viewing spot with a low horizon over the frozen sea with few artificial lights. Min. 6 people. Pick-up at hotels 18.00, return 22.00.



Dogsledding - Full day tour

Spend a full day dogsledding! Drive your own team of dogs through snowy forests and across frozen lakes.

A warm lunch is provided halfway through the journey. Enjoy the pure silence of Lapland while on your sled!

Duration: 6h, 10am- 4pm



Dogsledding - Drive your own team

Experience the thrill of dog sledding in the snowy landscapes around Brändön Lodge. After meeting the friendly huskies and receiving instructions at the nearby kennel, you and a partner will learn how to drive your own dog team along forest and lake trails. During the tour, your guide will share stories about life with sled dogs and the Arctic wilderness. This self-guided experience lasts approximately 1.5 hours and includes transfers from Brändön Lodge to the kennel. Minimum 2 people per booking.



Dogsledding - Ride on sled. 4-5 pax/sled

Enjoy an exciting dog sledding adventure at Brändön Lodge, perfect for larger groups and companies. After a short introduction and safety briefing, you'll ride on a sled driven by an experienced guide through snowy forests and across frozen lakes. The guide will share stories about the dogs, life as a dog sled driver, and the Arctic nature surrounding you. The experience lasts approximately 1 hour and offers unforgettable winter memories. Available for groups of minimum 10 people.

Relax



Sauna

Our outdoor sauna invites you to experience the raw beauty of the Nordic season—where crisp, icy air meets deep, enveloping heat. Surrounded by snow-covered landscapes and silent forests.



Hot tub

Listen to the waves of the ocean while enjoying the warmth of our hot tub. Whether under a sky filled with stars or the soft glow of winter daylight, our hot tub offers a unique escape—intimate, invigorating, and unforgettable.

Both the sauna and hot tub are located out on the point, surrounded by water. Only available in combination with the sauna.

How to get here



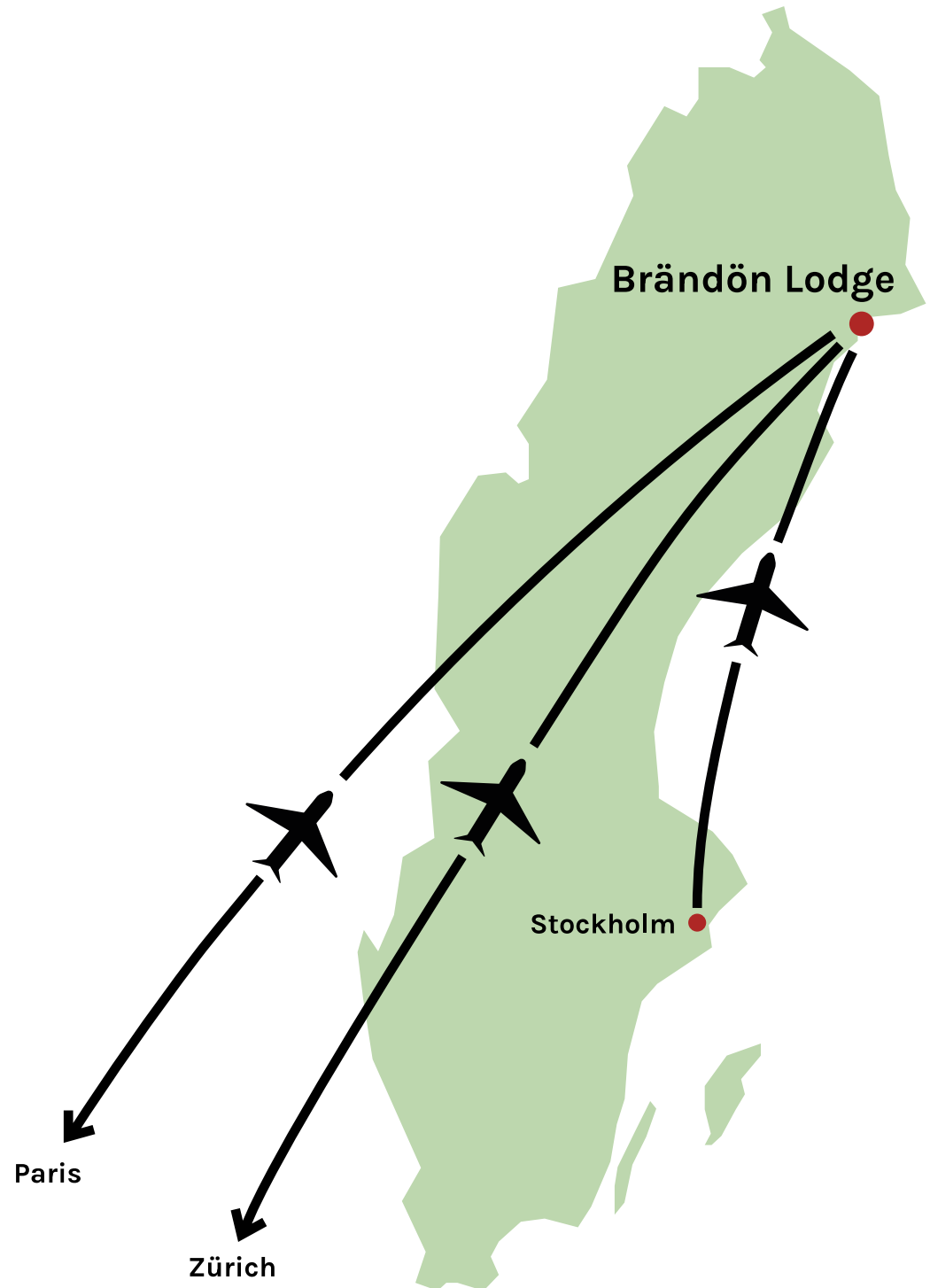
There are direct flights from Paris, Zürich, and Stockholm to Luleå Airport.

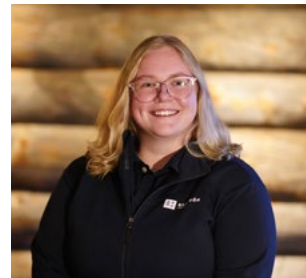

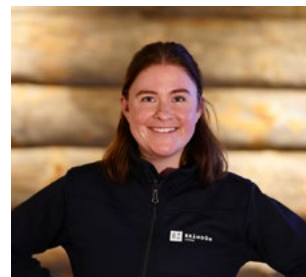
